**Cottingham Urban District**

**1864-1930**

**Historical Background:** The Newland portion of this district was incorporated in the City under the boundary extension of 1882 and additional portions under the extensions of 1929 and 1935.

**Description:** Street works papers: notices to owners as to street formation; agreements, awards, plans, specifications, contracts; bills of costs in connection with loans; bye-laws: letters.

**Related material:** The plans transferred to the City from various districts under the 1929 and 1936 extensions were merged into a single *Added Areas Group* with the reference TAB/38-9. (7 boxes)
