

C DBGB Gibson and Bishop, fruit importers, records 1957-1968

Accession number: 16/15

Historical Background: Gibson, Bishop and Co., fruit importers were first listed in the trade directory in 1897 at 10 1/2 Humber Dock Street, at the junction with Humber Street, and at the heart of Hull's Fruit Market. In 1924 the business was incorporated. With the proposed development of the Humber Street area, along with other businesses, Gibson Bishop & Co. moved to Priory Park in 2009. 2015 saw the business dissolved.

Custodial history: Found in the Gibson Bishop building on Humber Dock Street by the the new occupiers.
