Historical Background: William Kershaw, and his son, Allan, were insurance agents and brokers who operated out of 45 Danish Buildings, High Street, Hull.

Custodial history: All these records (except C DBK/3/8) had been deposited by Gilbert Baitson, auctioneers and valuers, of Anlaby Road. C DBK/3/8 (Acc. No. 62/94) had previously been catalogued under the reference C DMX/229. These had been found among the effects of Stuart Trout of Hessle and donated buy his daughter Mrs L. Wix.

Description: Copy letter book, letters regarding clients, letters and policy information from Scotish Equitable, day and cash books, journal, ledgers, receipts and invoices, property papers for Maxwell and Morley Streets, rent receipts and account books for W.F. Sanderson. Most items are dated between 1857-1968, except C DBK/3/8, which predates them at 1784.
