Historical Background: With its roots in the Presbyterian movement, the earliest date for the community which would later become the Unitarian Church is in 1680, when 2 congregations came together in a house on Bowlalley Lane. After a period of much disruption, the house was reopened for worship again in 1687 until it moved in 1693 to a new chapel, still on Bowlalley Lane. This was rebuilt in 1803, as an octagonal chapel and 1807 the congregation declared itself Unitarian. The move to Park Street came in 1881 and the present building, constructed on the same site dates, from 1977. The Society for the Reformation of Manners was made up of members of the Bowlalley Lane congregation, concerned over of the moral and social welfare of Hull's inhabitants.

Custodial history: These records appear to have been catalogued on an accessional basis, which has been continued to ensure a continuity of approach. All records have been deposited by the Church's historian and archivist.
