**Custodial history:** Transferred from the Hull Museum Service

**Description:** Most of the documents in this collection throw light on the lands and activities of the Boynton family in the 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> centuries. There are also documents relating to the fulling mills in Dewsbury in the 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> centuries and places in Lincolnshire and Staffordshire.
