

**C DIOT Photographic slides of Hull Ports and North Sea Ferries 1987**

**Historical Background:** The King George Dock, originally named the Hull Joint Dock, was opened in 1914. The Norstar was built in 1974 and operated by North Sea Ferries on the Hull-Rotterdam route between its launch and 1987, when it transferred to the Hull-Zeebrugge route. It was acquired by an Italian company in 2001 and broken up in 2010. These images were taken by Karl Heinz Knuyt, who died in March 2017.

**Custodial history:** Passed to the History Centre by Oliver Tickner, grandson of the depositer in March 2017

**Description:** Images of King George Dock and North Sea Ferries
