Historical Background: Daltry Street was the first school opened by the Hull School Board in 1874, and like many others, on the outbreak of Wolrd War II, the boys were evacuated out of the city in 1939. Initially opened as a combined infants and junior school in 1930, Eastfield Road Junior School opened as a separate entity in 1936.

Custodial history: Deposited in March (the booklet and programme) and April (for the photograph) 2022, by Ruth Pickles, the neice of the accompanist for the Concert and Show at Eastfield Road Junior School, Mr W. Crickmore.

Description: Evacuation plan for Daltry Street Boys School, a programme for Concert and Show at Eastfield Road Junior School and a photograph of children with lanterns probably the procession mentioned in the concert programme.
