He was a coach driver and keen photographer, taking images both locally but also whilst visiting other areas of the country and Europe before his death in 1995. These photographs relate to Hull and the immediate area.

Description: Various photographs taken of Hull and the immediate area over the lifetime by Alan Robinson. These include images of Hull, the immediate area, Hull Fair, ships, shipping and docks.
