**Historical Background:** Situated along Holderness Road close to its junction with Witham, East Hull Baths opened in 1898. Run by the local authority, Hull Corporation, later Hull City Council and its subsidiary, Hull Culture & Lesiure Ltd, it was redeveloped over the years. Popular among Hull residents for swimming and other leisure activities, it closed in April 2018 when the Woodford Leisure Centre in East Hull was redeveloped.
