**The Records of the Hull Seamens and  
General Orphanage**

**1853-1986**

**Historical Background:**

The Hull Mariners Church Orphan Society was established in 1853 to provide clothing and education for orphans of Hull, preference being given to children of seamen. The society later changed its name to Hull Seamens and General Orphan Society and opened a residential home on Spring Bank in 1866. The orphanage moved to Hesslewood in 1921 until its closure in 1985.

Sources for family history before 1866

Prior to 1866 children received clothing and education but continued to live in their own homes.

1. Minute book (C DSHO/1/1) lists the names, ages and addresses of children receiving aid.
2. Application book (C DSHO/4/1) lists child's name, age, address, name of father, number of family at home, mother's means of living, date of application, and remarks.
3. Class book (C DSHO/4/13) children receiving aid were required to attend National Day Schools and the Mariners Church on Sundays. The surviving class book records the name and school attendance of boys only. The name of the school is not provided.

Records of the Orphanage after 1866

1. Admission registers (C DSHO/4/17-22). Two series of registers were kept, one for boys and the other for girls. Both are indexed and record name, date of birth, address, particulars of parents, when elected, date of admittance, leaving date and reason, as well as notes relating to their subsequent history, if known.
2. Election papers (C DSHO/4/9-10). Prior to 1922 children were chosen for admission to the orphanage by a ballot system. Subscribers to the orphanage cast votes and children receiving the highest number of votes were admitted. The election papers list children seeking admission with particulars of their family circumstances and addresses. These are useful for finding information relating to children who tried to enter the home but were unsuccessful.
3. Applications for admission (C DSHO/4/2-8)
4. Leavers register (C DSHO/4/28). Indexed volume giving date of departure, address and occupation/reason for leaving.

Outside Branch (C DSHO/4/23)

Some children continued to be assisted in their own homes after 1866. The surviving register for the "outside" children provides the same information as the admission registers mentioned above and covers the years 1914-1923.

### Other items of interest

The records include births and baptism certificates (C DSHO/4/25-27), punishment book (C DSHO/4/30), scrap books (C DSHO/2/56-60), and various photographs.

Matron's reports books (C DSHO/1/40-44), holds mid-monthly minutes and details of admissions and departures, illness, gifts and were completed by the staff and the girls.
