

C TCDA Hull Town Council Dock Accommodation Committee 1836-1838

Historical Background: The committee was created after a public meeting on the 26 March 1836 called upon the Corporation to develop dock accommodation in Hull. Having presented its report, the committee was wound up.

Custodial History: Records created as part of the work of the Dock Accommodation Committee and routinely transferred from the Town Clerks Department

Description: Resolutions, minutes, letters and reports. Former reference number TCDE.
