## Records of the Hull Town Council Shipping Dues Committee

1850-1861

**Historical Background:** In February 1857 Hull Town Council had intimated, due to potential changes suggested by parliament, that there was a need to revive the committee to look at the issue of dues it was owed by shipping coming into the port. This committee had met before as the Port Dues Committee in the early 1850s. The new committee would become the Shipping Dues Committee (but it was also known as the Differential Dues Committee). Having reported back, the committee was wound up in August 1861.

**Custodial History:** Records created as part of the work of the Shipping Dues Committee and routinely transferred from the Town Clerks Department

**Description:** Minutes of meetings, accounts, charges and other financial information

Extent: 8 items 1 bundle

**Related Materials:** See council minutes in the searchroom which also contain any associated reports. In addition, there are the records of the Hull Water Bailiffs at C WB and that of the Hull Woolhouse at C WW with Customs Bills of Entry at L.387.
