**Hull Town Council West Hartlepool
Harbour and Railway Bill Committee**

1861

Historical Background: The Town Council set up the committee in January 1861, as a response to the move by the West Hartlepool Harbour and Railway Company to extend its own operations. It was wound up in July 1861 after the bill was passed by Parliament, as the Cleveland Railway Act.
