L DSKS HULL KINGSTON SWIMMING CLUB 1886-1979

Historical Background:

The Hull Kingston Swimming Club was formed on 5th August 1886 as an amateur club for men with the intention of teaching and to encourage the 'Art of Swimming'. Its motto was 'Kingston First'. It grew at an astonishing rate with more than 200 members being enrolled in its first year.

In April 1890 the Club became affiliated with the Northern Counties Swimming Association. A branch for Ladies with its own Captain and Committee was established in 1913 and it quickly grew in popularity. In 1931 more than half of the club's members were female.

Jack Hale (1922-2008) the clubs most famous member, won 38 Yorkshire Titles between 1937-1957 and was Commonwealth Champion and Olympic finalist. He is widely credited for inventing the 'dolphin method' of using his feet on the butterfly stroke.

The early minute books in particular contain considerable detail about the club's negotiations with the Corporation's Baths Committee to secure exclusive access, at a discounted rate, to the baths for one night a week to allow the club members to practise. There is also correpsondence relating to improving the facilities at Madeley Street and Trippett baths and whether they could be kept open during the winter months.

In June 1887 one of the Club's junior members rescued a lad from Queen's Dock and it was agreed that all

substatiated rescue's by club members would be awarded a medal from the club and the minute books often provide details of rescues.

The club's first competion was held in July 1887 and this quickly became an annual competion or gala with the minute books recording details relating to the choice of events, their organisation and the results. 6 items
