Historical Background: Created by the Borough of Kingston upon Hull during the course of business regarding land and property owned and administered by them

Custodial History: Originally in the possession of the Town Clerk, transferred to Hull City Archives

Description: Collection contains various records relating to the administration of property by the Borough of Kingston upon Hull. Records include plans, inventories, powers of attorney, agreements, Holderness drainage reports and papers, grass and farm accounts, surveys etc.

Arrangement: Largely chronological although some items are out of sequence
