Historical Background/Biographical Background: Mr. R. G. Tarran, Founder and Principal of the firm Tarran Industries Ltd. in Hull, recruited volunteers to the Tarran Artisan Company Royal Engineers, which included some of his own craftsmen, tradesmen, artisans and technicians. A complimentary and farewell dinner took place on the 12th February 1940 and just two days later the company set off to their training quarters for intensive training prior to going overseas to work on the maintenance of lines of communication, etc.

Custodial history: Some of the papers were inherited by Mr. Ronald Bunton from his father and the rest he collected. Mr. Ronald Bunton deposited the papers in April 2013.
