Biographical Background: William Glenton (1890-1974). Glenton was a shipwright carpenter and worked on Hull's William Wright Dock. Hull was heavily bombed during the Second World War.

Custodial history: Compiled by Glenton and deposited by Janet Grimes, a family member in April 2014.

Description: Compiled by William Alfred Glenton. Details include date, time of bombing, duration of the attack and sometimes location detailing if there were fatalities. A sheet with biographical details of William Glenton is included as well.
