**Biographical Background:** Collected and written by Norman Grundy who was born in Hull in 1934. His cousin, Eric Grundy was aboard the M.T. Gaul which was lost off the coast of northern Norway in 1974.

**Custodial history:** Deposited by Norman Grundy in September 2015

**Description:** Reminiscences entitled 'The Times of My Life' (2015); Letter to Mrs Grundy from the Minister of Health regarding evacuated children (1941) and a note regarding Mr N. Grundys' cousin, Eric Grundy, lost on the M.T. Gaul (c.2015).
