Historical Background: Agreements and Crew Lists, (ACLs), were introduced in 1835. The agreement was used by the ship's Master (Captain), to record the conditions of employment of the crew for the voyage and period of service. The agreement was agreed by each seaman before the ship sailed. The resultant crew lists were used by the Board of Trade registry clerks to create the entries in the various seamen's registers.

Custodial history: Initially compiled by the Mercantile Marine Office they were then transferred to the Public Record Office (The National Archives) who, in 1978 passed them onto local record offices. These agreements were part of those originally sent to the North East Lincolnshire Archives before being transferred to the Hull History Centre in 2011.

Description: Part of the yearly returns, the agreements contain the names of the vessels, owners, skippers, crew and any major events that occurred on board.
