## C GN The Newington Water Company, records 1873-1968

**Historical Background:** The Newington Waterworks, on Albert Avenue were erected by David Parkinson Garbutt in 1874 and transferred to the Newington Water Company, of which he was director. A year later, in 1875, the company was authorised to supply water to the St. John's, Newland and Newington areas. The waterworks were closed down after the company was taken over by the Hull Corporation under the Newington Water Order, 1893.

**Description:** Deeds of property purchased by the company, 1874-1879; Agreements for the supply of water to Newington and Cottingham, 1873-1874; Agreements and plans as to water pipes, 1875-1968.
