Historical Background/Biographical Background: Simon King, Project Manager of Pattie Slappers project has provided the following text for the project: In 2012 CERT Ltd were awarded a grant from the Heritage Lottery Fund to create a book, audio archive and exhibition which would tell the stories of people that were affectionately known in Hull as 'Pattie Slappers'. These people worked in the frozen food and fish filleting industry that sat alongside the docks and formed a vital part of the cities industry for many years.

Pattie slappers were given this name for the work they did in creating a Hull Pattie. The Pattie consists of potato, herbs and occasionally onion and would be 'slapped' into a round mould ready for freezing. This would then be fried in chip shops in the city or packaged up to be sent out across the country.

The 'Pattie Slappers' project was developed and delivered by CERT Ltd, a Humber wide social enterprise that specialise in regeneration and training.

In 2012 there were plans for developing large areas of the city to accommodate new industry that would see the city thrive once again. However, there were a number of residential areas and former workplaces that were being demolished without pausing to capture what once had been.

The Pattie Slappers project was developed to give those people that lived and worked in the area a chance to tell their stories of the difficulties faced in working in the industry but also the culture that was created and the fun that was had to make the best of tough work.

Participants in the project were interviewed and provided a wide range of opinions, stories and memories from their time working as 'Pattie Slappers'. Stories ranged from practical jokes played on bosses and the social scene that came with the job, to the strong sense of community that existed around the fishing industry and the pace of life as a 'Pattie Slapper', which often involved managing time between a busy home life and tough, smelly, manual work.

The project saw CERT Ltd work with local voluntary organisations to train their volunteers to help with interviewing and archiving skills, work with local schools to get their thoughts and to interview 'Pattie Slappers' themselves, create an exhibition which ran for a month at the Street Life museum and the printing of 1000 books which were close to being sold out by Christmas 2014.

Profits from the book sales are donated to local organisations to support their work in capturing local heritage and to commemorate the many Hull fishermen lost at sea.

Dr Alan Dowling was born in 1932 at the Model Dwellings, a block of working-class flats on the corner of St. Luke's Street and Midland Street near the centre of Hull. He was the last of eight children. In this self-published memoir, Alan gives an insight into the lives of his parents (both born in Hull) and his experiences growing up in Hull where the family opened a bakery shop on Walker Street (no. 117) which later sold more general groceries. He then goes on to describe what life was like in Hull during the Second World War and his family's move to Leeds and subsequent return to Hull after the war ended. He describes his education in post-war Hull and his National Service 1950-1952. Alan eventually became a Librarian taking up senior roles first in Scunthorpe and, later, Grimsby. Manuscript indexes to the fair copies of Muster Rolls made for retention by Trinity House Hull. These indexes were compiled by Professor Donald Woodward during the course of his work as honourary Archivist at the Trinity House in Hull. They are available to view in the search room in Transript boxes 7 & 8.

Muster Rolls taken by shipmasters and providing details of a ship's crew and voyages, were required to be kept under the Act for the Relief of Disabled Seamen passed in 1747. This Act established the Seamen's Fund to provide for the welfare of seamen. Under the terms of the Seamen's Fund shipmasters were responsible for collecting monthly contributions of 6 pence from each crew member. These contributions were collected at the end of each voyage and given to appointed Collectors or Receivers by shipmasters at the port of arrival, at which time the individual ship's muster roll was submitted for filing. Trinity House Hull was responsible for providing Collectors at the ports of Hull, Gainsborough. Goole, Grimsby, and Bridlington, and it is to these ports that the Trinity House Muster Rolls relate.

The following information was required to be entered into the muster roll: Ship name; Ship master's name and place of abode; Ship's tonnage; Port sailed from; Port arrived into. The following information relating to individual crewmen was also required: Name; Age; Place of birth; Place of abode; First ship and master served with; When and where entered current ship; When and where discharged, run, or killed; When and where injured or wounded; Number of months and days on board ship. Muster Rolls also record the amount of money received by the Collector and the date on which this was received. Please note that the information actually provided is not always complete in each instance.

Reference for original muster rolls: C DSTR

Please note that the original volumes did include loose indexes that record the ship's name, master's name and page numbers as they appear in the volumes, however, these modern transcribed indexes occasionally contain additional information, taken from the Muster Rolls such as where the ship was from, what class of ship it was (ie; sloop, keel etc) and the type of trade it was involved in or the country/countries it traded with.

Please also note that the indexes for volume 47 (C DSTR/45 29 May 1830-29 Feb 1832) and volume 49 (C DSTR/47 6 Mar 1833-31 Dec 1834) do not have a modern transcription but a C SRL/T reference has been assigned to them should they be transcribed at a later date.
