Historical Background: The Hull Local Board of Health was initially responsible for parks and burials in Hull until its functions were subsumed within Hull Corporation in the late 19th century.

Custodial history: The first set of plans were transferred from Leisure Services in 1999. The second set were originally from the Parks Department within Leisure Services at 79 Ferensway who then moved to Kingston House. These plans were transferred to Hull City Archives as a result the move by NPS into new premises.

Description: Plans for East Park, Pearson Park, Pickering Park, Ferens and Pickering Boating Lakes and Tower Grange Miniature Golf Course : Painting of a design for Paragon Street and King Edward Street and a design for Queen's Gardens.
