

C TCMH Records of the Hull City Council Mental Health 1942-1945
Services (Special) and Mental Health Services Committees

Historical Background: The Mental Health Committee was established in July 1942 to investigate provision in Hull as a consequence of the 'inevitable increase in Neurosis and Nervous Disease and Child Delinquency in the city as a result of war conditions'. It was made up of representatives of the Health, Mental Hospital, Care of the Mentally Defective and Education Committees. It was disbanded in March 1945. One of its recommendations was the setting up of a Mental Health Services Committee which was created in June 1944 and continued until April 1945 when its functions were taken over by the Health, Mental Hospital and Care of the Mentally Defective Committees.

Custodial history: Records created as part of the work of the Mental Health Services (Special) and Mental Health Services Committees and routinely transferred from the Town Clerks Department
