Historical Background: The Hull New Theatre's origins began 1924 with the Hull Repertory Company, who performed in the Little Theatre, a converted lecture theatre. The company engaged Peppino Santangelo to run the theatre, and with his drive and enthusiasm 1939 saw the New Theatre open, utilising the existing building and the assembly rooms next door. In 1961, Hull City Council took over the theatre after some difficult financial times. 1968, 1985 and 1995 saw major refurbishment work at the theatre.
