Historical Background: Humberside District Councils Association came into existence as a result of local government reorganisation in 1973. It was for the nine councils that made up the districts in Humberside. These were: Beverley Borough Council, Boothferry Borough Council, Cleethorpes Borough Council, East Yorkshire Borough Council, Glanford Borough Council, Great Grimsby Borough Council, Holderness Borough Council and Scunthorpe Borough Council. The organisation was wound up when Humberside was abolished in 1994.
