**Records relating to Rolston Camp**

**1939-1979**

**Historical Background:** Rolston Camp lies in the village of Mappleton, 19 km from Hull. The camp was originally set up in 1939 under the auspices of the Jubilee Holiday Trust Fund set up by Archibald Stark a Hull cinema manager. In 1950 the City Council took over the camp. It was run by Humberside County Council from 1974 until it was passed back to Hull City Council in 1989. It was closed in 1992. The site required substantial investment which the trust, which still administered the camp, were unable to fund and was put up for sale in 2002. It was still for sale in December 2010.

**Custodial history:** The correspondence and booking applications were transferred from the Town Clerks Department in February 1983, whilst the copy trust deed was transferred from Kingston House Reception in 2011.
