Historical Background: Commemorative collection of ship illustrations reproduced by the Hull Daily Mail marking 200 years of Ships of Hull, 1780-1980.

Custodial history: Deposited by Margaret Camp whose mother was in possession of the prints.

Description: A series of 12 black and white reproduced illustrations of Hull vessels from the collections of the Ferens Art Gallery, reproduced by the Hull Daily Mail to mark 200 years of Ships of Hull, 1780-1980.

Includes a brief description and history by Arthur Credland, the former keeper of Maritime History at Hull's Maritime Museum.
