Historical Background: In 1874, Anne Popple, who had lived in the village, provided funds in her will, for the erection of a drinking fountain in Welton, East Yorkshire. This volume was compiled by W. Milne as a record of the development of the fountain.

Custodial history: Acquired by Hull Libraries as part of the Wilson-Barkworth Collection in 1929

Description: Includes plans, engravings, letters and a photograph
