Biographical Background:

Gavin Ewart first published poems at the age of 17 in Geoffrey Grigson's New verse of 1933. After graduating at Christ's College, Cambridge, he served in the Royal Artillery from 1940 to 1946, and worked for the British Council from 1946 to 1952, and then as a copywriter in advertising until 1971, when he became a full-time freelance writer. He became a Fellow of the Royal Society of Literature in 1981.
