Biographical background:

Fred Gray studied at the University of Hull between 1968 and1971 before completing his PhD in Geography at Cambridge University. In 1974 he became a research fellow at Sussex University. During his tenure at Sussex University he served as the Director of the Centre for Continuing Education for over a decade, as the Dean of the Sussex Institute (2002-2009) and as the Academic Director of Local and Regional Relationships (2009-2011). He is now an Emeritus Professor of Continuing Education.

Alongside his academic career, Professor Gray is a Director of the West Pier Trust, for whom he also acts as honorary historian and archivist, and the Brighton Fishing Museum Trust. He has also served as a board member for the Brighton Dome and Festival, Varndean College Brighton and the Gardner Arts Centre.
